Please be advised that the Sunshine Canyon Landfill Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Joint Technical Document (JTD) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Sunshine Canyon Landfill. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the jurisdiction of the Sunshine Canyon Landfill Local Enforcement Agency.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

The Sunshine Canyon Landfill is an approximately 363-acre existing landfill site located at 14747 San Fernando Road in Sylmar, California. The landfill is permitted to accept 12,100 tons per day during the hours of 6:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday and 7:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturday.

On December 10, 2012, the LEA received an application package from Browning Ferris Industries of California, Inc. (BFI) for a JTD Amendment for the Sunshine Canyon Landfill. The JTD Amendment was submitted to update the following sections:

- Landfill Gas-To-Energy Facility – Include the landfill gas-to-energy facility that was recently approved by SCAQMD into the JTD and landfill site plan;
- Odor Control – Include the recently installed orchard fans and dust boss into the JTD.
- Contact Information - Update the JTD to reflect the new management and provide emergency contact information;
- CalRecycle – Updated the JTD to reflect that the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) is now the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle).

The LEA has determined that the application package is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. On January 9, 2013, the LEA approved the JTD amendment.
